PARENT COFFEE MORNING - STAYING SAFE ONLINE

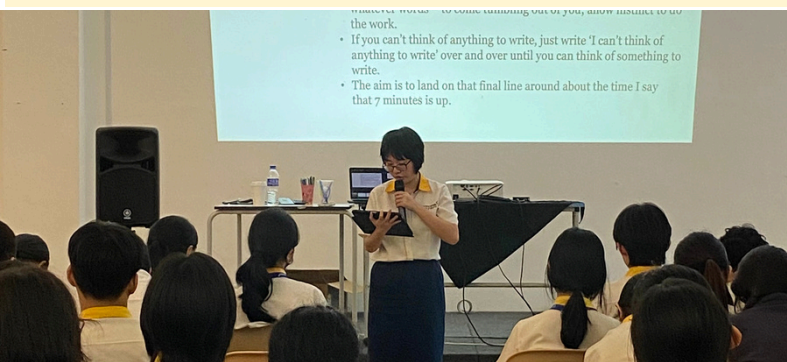
We warmly invite all parents to join us for our upcoming Parent Coffee Morning, where we will be discussing 'Staying Safe Online' — a timely and important topic for families today.

STUDENT'S ACHIEVEMENTS

Congratulations to Isaac Loh Qi Jie (Year 7) on his outstanding achievement at the Final Selection for Team Malaysia to the World Championships of Performing Arts (WCOA).

The national finals were held on 20 December 2025 at Panggung Bangsawan, Melaka, where Isaac competed against finalists selected from across Johor and Malaysia. He was awarded a Gold Medal and a RM2,000 scholarship, marking a significant milestone in his performing arts journey. The event was attended by a full audience, including representatives from the Melaka State Government and the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture Malaysia.

As a result of this achievement, Isaac has been officially selected to represent Malaysia at WCOA 2026, often regarded as the Olympics of Performing Arts. The championships will take place in July 2026 at the Westgate Las Vegas Resort and Casino, USA. Prior to the event, Team Malaysia members will undergo two months of professional training with industry experts from Hollywood, Nashville and New York.

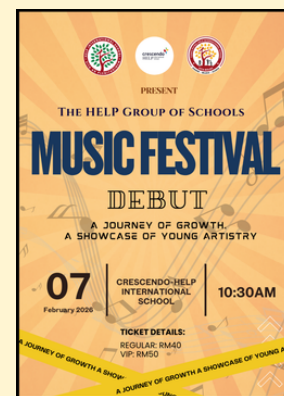
There are still some tickets available for the Music Festival performance on Feb 7th at 10.30 am. It will be a spectacular event with 200 performers from the three HELP schools.
